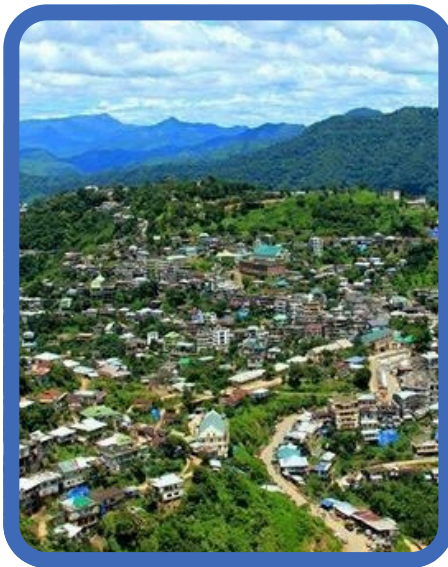

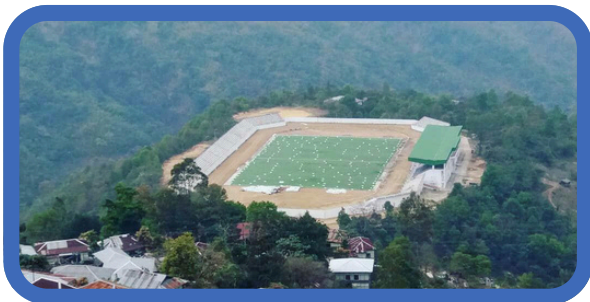
ABOUT SERCHHIP



Serchhip is adjoined by Champhai District in the East, Aizawl in the North and North West and Lunglei District in the South. Serchhip District is occupying the central part of the state with its headquarters at Serchhip Town. The district has been carved out of old Aizawl District vide Government of Mizoram Notification No. A.60011/2/95-GAD dt 29.7.1998. The District with an area of 1,421 sq.km is the 8th among all eight districts in Mizoram. Serchhip District is located between 23°35'N and 23° N latitude and between 92°41' E and 93°10' E longitude.

The district is located right in the central part of the State. The district is bounded on the north and northwest by Aizawl District, on the west and south by Lunglei district, on the southeast by Myanmar (Burma), and on the east by Champhai District. The district has an average altitude of approximately 1044 mtrs from MSL. Serchhip, the district headquarter has an altitude of 1281 mtrs from MSL.

The nearest airport from Serchhip is Lengpui Airport and the nearest railway station is Sairang railway station. From Aizawl, the capital of Mizoram, Serchhip is 110km (approx.), roughly a three-hour drive through the picturesque NH 54. July is a month of the rainy season, so temperatures around this month is expected to be cool and pleasant, with lots of rainfall.

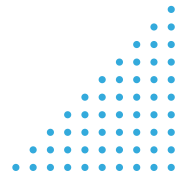

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Articles should contain 3500-4000 words in length including references, footnotes, tables and figures.
- Times New Roman should be used for writing an article with font size 12pts. Line spacing should be 1.5 and alignment must be justified.
- All references should be formatted according to APA or MLA referencing style.
- Full paper should be submitted in Microsoft Word (.docx).
- AI usage must be avoided.
- Full paper submission should include abstract, keywords, body and references.
